Responding to the Opioid Epidemic (Category III; 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.)

This course will provide funeral directors with a basic understanding of how to assist families of overdose victims with funeral planning, the challenges families face and ways funeral directors can become more involved in the community to address this growing epidemic. A review of OSHA related prep room concerns will be included. Discussion, ideas, questions, and comments are encouraged throughout the program.

Restorative Techniques in Cases of Trauma and Mass Casualties (Category IV; Noon – 4:30 p.m.)

Gain confidence in full restoration and reconstruction work when preparing a body for viewing. New methods and techniques will be emphasized for assessing a wide variety of trauma injuries and concerns of mass casualties. Updates on embalming problems will be presented. OSHA awareness and compliance for funeral directors will be discussed to help maintain a safe working environment. Questions and comments are encouraged.
