ANNUAL MINE SAFETY AND HEALTH ADMINISTRATION (MSHA) For Surface Operations, Contractors and Truckers MSHA Mine Safety Refresher Courses

Mine Safety and Health Administration (MSHA) training is designed for vendors, suppliers and contractors who employ truck drivers at mine sites engaged in shell dredging or employed in sand, gravel, surface stone or clay and surface lime-stone operations.

The safety training will consist of a combination of approaches including PowerPoint presentations, short video clips and interactive discussions.
