As of January 1, 1993, the State of Wisconsin requires all prospective insurance agents for all product lines to attend an approved course of study before taking the insurance exam. The Office of the Commissioner of Insurance requires that all applicants attend 8 hours of Principles of Insurance Ethics and Law plus 12 hours of education directly related to the product line. The 8-hour Ethics and Law component needs to be taken within the last 12 months before your exam.

All sections listed on this schedule meet the hour requirements as required by the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance. Moraine Park Technical College will issue course completion certificates.

OR

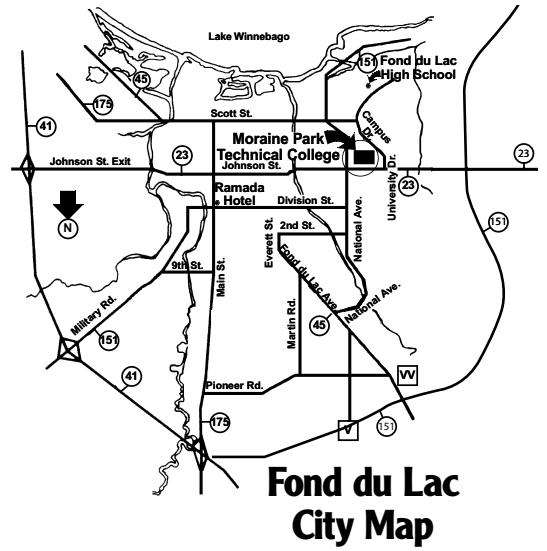
You registered for a class that began August 26, 2008 or later.
