

WAUPUN UTILITIES/WPPI ENERGY \$1,000 ELECTRIC LINE TECHNICIAN TRAINING SCHOLARSHIP

High school graduates may be eligible to win a \$1,000 scholarship. Applicant must be a high school student at time of application. To qualify, the student's parents or legal guardian must be a customer of Waupun Utilities and/or reside in the City of Waupun when the application is submitted. Dependents of Waupun Utilities' personnel are also eligible to apply. Scholarship criteria, information, and application form can also be found on our website at:

The Application Process

Any high school senior who plans on attending an Electrical Power Distribution Program, preferably at one the five Wisconsin of Technical Colleges that offer courses, may complete a student application form available in their school Guidance Office. Interested applicants should note this is a very popular program and some schools in Wisconsin have waiting lists.

The application requests the student's name; name of parents their or legal quardian; address; phone number; and the high school they are attending. The applicant is required to attach a recommendation from letter а teacher. counselor, or employer that addresses the applicant's skills that are pertinent.

Criteria & Award

The Waupun Utilities Scholarship Review Committee will evaluate the applications, and the scholarship will be awarded in May.

The Deadline

Application forms must be submitted to Eric Kostecki at Waupun Utilities no later than April 9, 2021.

Payment

Payment of the scholarship to the winner will be done in two installments: the first installment will be paid after proof of registration is provided to Waupun Utilities; the second installment will be paid after completion of the Electric Power Distribution Program.



Waupun Utilities/WPPI Energy Electric Line Technician Training Scholarship Program Criteria

Scholarship Purpose

A \$1,000 scholarship (\$500 from WPPI Energy Inc.) authorized by the Waupun Utilities Commission will be offered for the 2020-2021 school year, to a graduating senior. The primary purposes of offering a scholarship in conjunction with WPPI are to encourage technical training for high school graduates, to educate youth about careers in their own community, to create an incentive for trained lineworkers to seek employment in WPPI member municipalities, to provide WPPI member municipal utilities with a pool of trained linemen, and to inform customers about the benefits of owning a municipal utility.

Scholarship Process

 Applicant must be a high school senior who plans on attending an Electrical Power Distribution program, preferably at one of the five Wisconsin Technical Colleges that offers courses -

> Blackhawk Technical College (Janesville) Chippewa Valley Technical College (course held in Eau Claire) Milwaukee Area Technical College Moraine Park Technical College (course held in Beaver Dam) Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (Green Bay)

- 2) The student, their parent or legal guardian must be a customer of Waupun Utilities and/or reside in the City of Waupun when the application is submitted. Dependents of utility personnel are also eligible to apply.
- 3) A letter of recommendation is required from a teacher, counselor, or employer that addresses the applicant's skills that are pertinent to the job (ex. manually dexterous; in good physical condition; willing to work at all heights and in all weather; able to comprehend and follow written instructions; safety conscious).
- 4) The application and letter of recommendation should be submitted to Eric Kostecki at Waupun Utilities, no later than April 9, 2021.
- 5) The Waupun Utilities Scholarship Review Committee will review the applications. Confidentiality of the applications and recommendations will be strictly honored and viewed only by the Review Committee.
- 6) The scholarship prize will be announced and awarded in May.
