

## ELIGIBILITY

In order to qualify for SSS, students must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Be accepted in a Moraine Park Technical College degree, diploma or certificate program and be enrolled for at least 6 credits.
- Be in need of academic support.
- Be highly motivated to graduate and/or transfer to a bachelor's degree-granting institution.
- Meet one or more of the following:
  - a. Family income meets published federal guidelines (low income) found at [www.ed.gov](http://www.ed.gov), search TRIO low income
  - b. Neither parent has a bachelor's degree (first generation)
  - c. Have a documented disability
