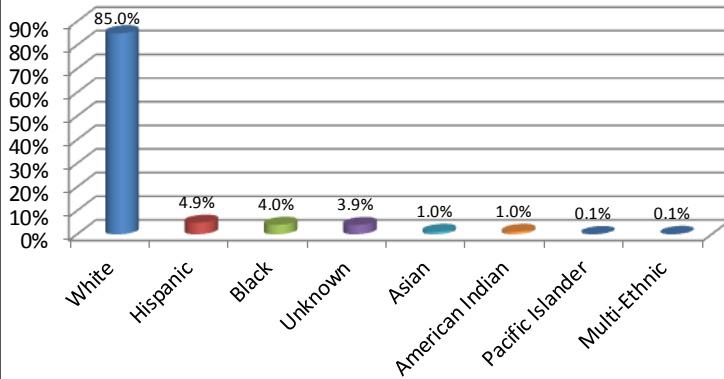

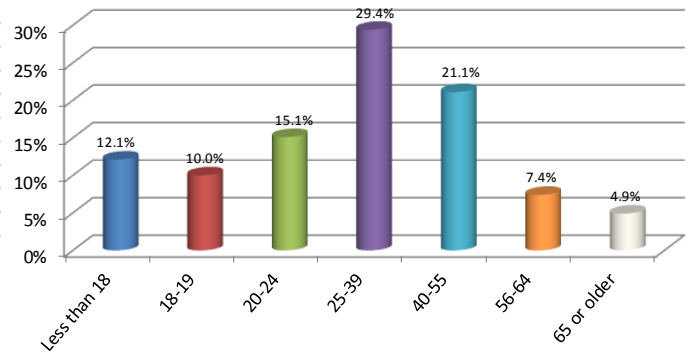

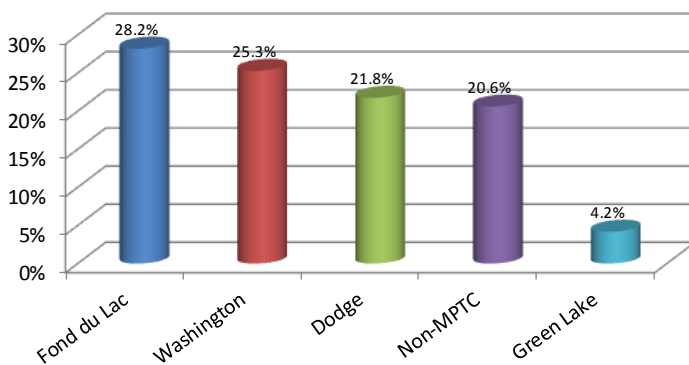
## Ethnicity



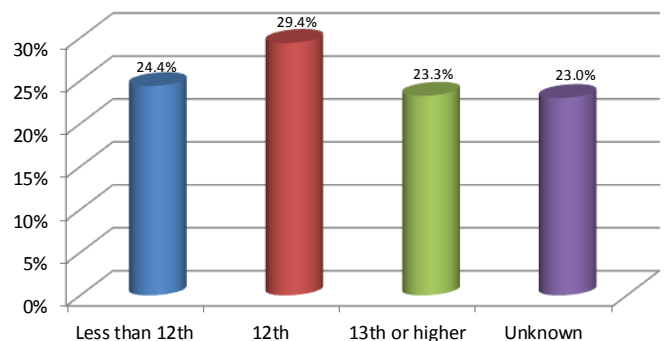
## Age Demographics

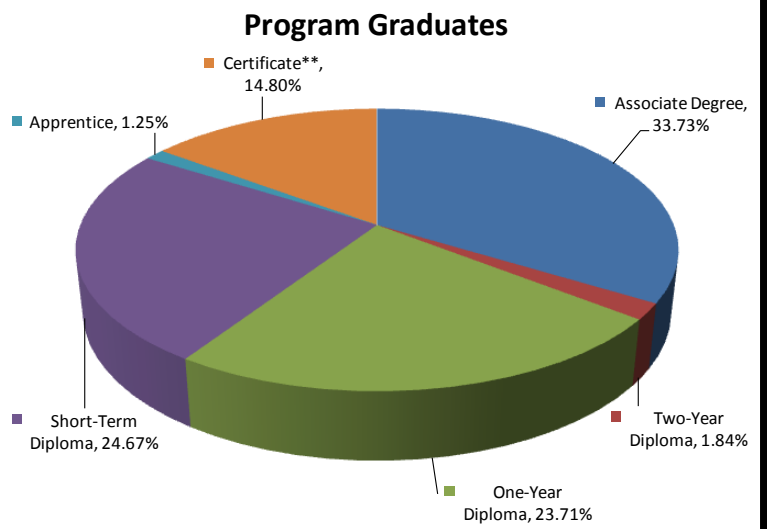
