The Administrative Credential

The Early Childhood Administrative Credential Certificate is comprised of six courses (18 credits) that address the many roles of program administrators and directors in early childhood settings. The coursework is designed for current administrators, supervisors and child care teachers from early childhood settings who want to gain more knowledge in areas such as staffing, budget development, facilities management, determining community needs, understanding laws and regulations as well as best practices and performance standards.

MPTC offers all of the Administrative Credential courses on-line in a six-week accelerated format.

Fall

- Administrative and Supervision
- Operations Management

Spring

- Early Childhood Programs and the External Environment
- Best Practices
- Administrative Seminar

The Infant/Toddler Credential

The Infant/Toddler Credential Certificate is comprised of four courses (12 credits) that specifically focus on providing care to children from birth to three years of age. Students learn the emotional, mental and physical development for these ages; how to create developmentally appropriate activities; how to guide behaviors; and how to be sensitive to the needs of infants and toddlers. These skills are applied as part of a student internship.

MPTC offers all of the Infant/Toddler Credential courses.

Fall

- Infant and Toddler Development (face-to-face, FDL & WB Campuses)
- Infant/Toddler Capstone (blended)

Spring

- Group Care for Infants and Toddlers (face-to-face/IVC BD, FDL, & WB Campuses)
- Family & Community Relationships (face-to-face, WB Campus and IVC BD,FDL, & WB Campuses)

The Preschool Credential

The Early Childhood Preschool Credential was developed using courses from the Wisconsin Technical College System Statewide Curriculum for the Associate Degree in Early Childhood Education. This six course, 18-credit Registry Credential program is for preschool teachers, assistant teachers, program directors and administrators who work with children age three to five.

MPTC offers all of the Preschool Credential courses.

Fall

- Health, Safety and Nutrition (on-line)
- Guiding Children's Behavior (face-to-face, FDL & WB Campuses)
- Art, Music and Language Arts (face-to-face, FDL & WB Campuses)

Spring

- Foundations of Early Childhood Education (on-line)
- Child Development (face-to-face, FDL & WB Campuses)
- Preschool Capstone (blended) -
 - Enrollment in this course may be concurrent with only one other course in the credential but <u>all</u> other credential courses must be successfully completed.
 - The student must be working with children ages 3-5 years old while participating in this course or be willing to be placed by MPTC in a preschool age classroom. A minimum of 50 classroom hours with preschool age children must be completed by the end of the course. Schedule to be determined by student and MPTC instructor.
