

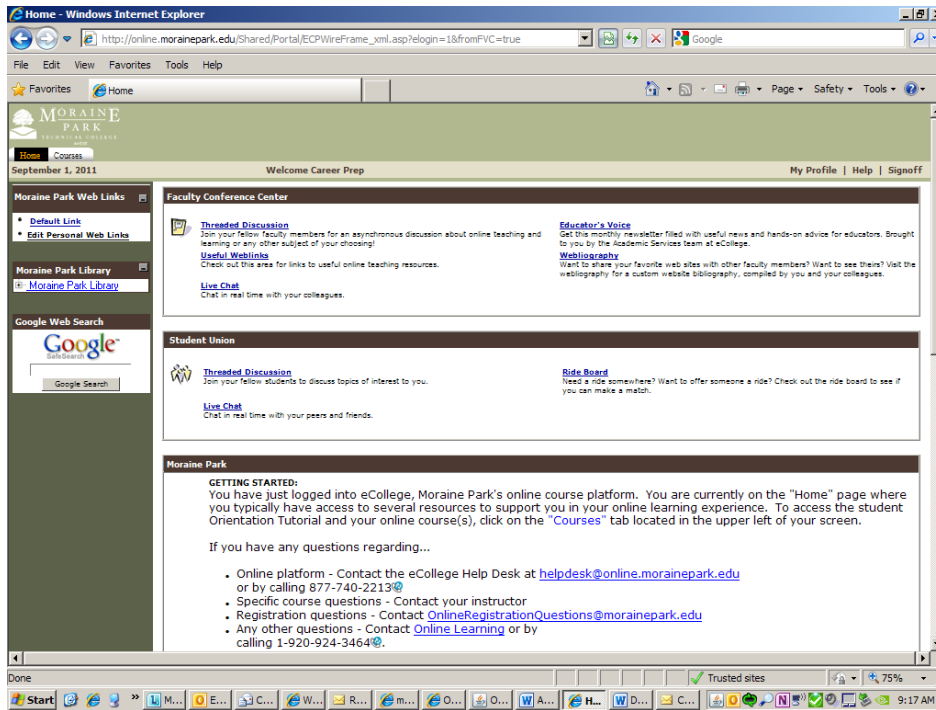

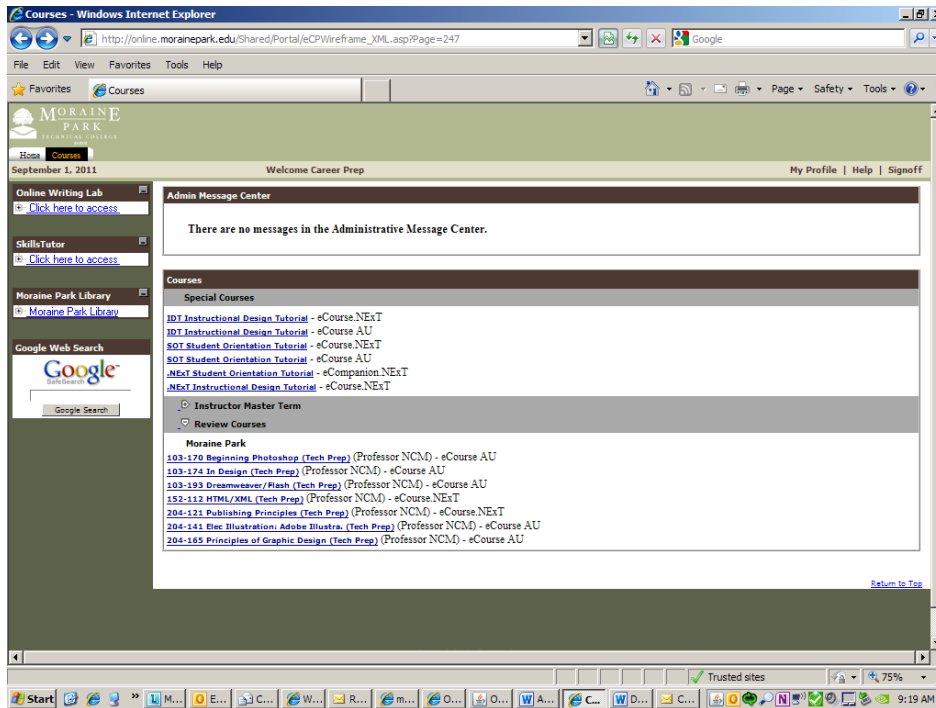

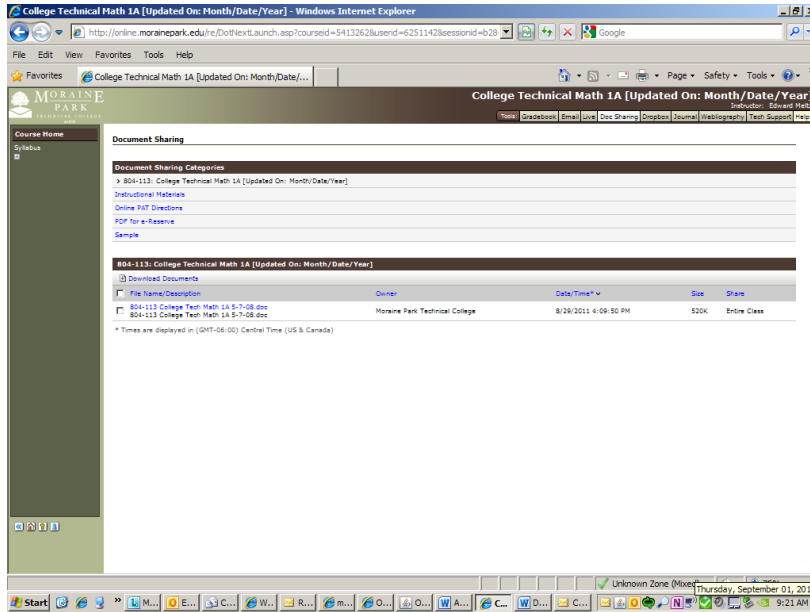


Please click on "Courses" on the top left-hand corner of the page.

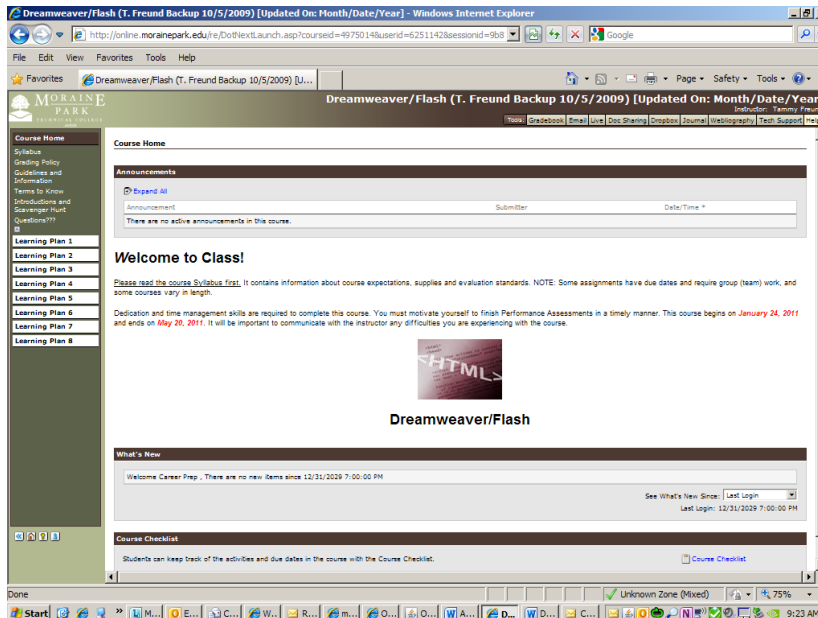


To find a listing of all the courses, you can search under Moraine Park and also click on "Instructor Master Term" for a complete listing. If you can find not your course, please contact me.
