Summer session is considered part of the academic year. The 2016-2017 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) applies for aid for the fall 2016, spring 2017 and summer 2017 semesters. You are eligible to apply for summer aid if you meet all of the following:

1. Currently accepted in an eligible program as a regular degree-seeking student prior to or for the summer term.
2. Have a completed 2016-2017 financial aid file (including any verification documentation required).
3. Have remaining eligibility.
4. Have maintained satisfactory progress.

IMPORTANT: If you do not meet all above criteria, your Summer Financial Aid Application will not be processed. You will be notified via your student e-mail when the review is complete.

If all eligibility was used during the 2016-2017 fall and spring semesters (i.e., you were full-time both semesters or used the annual federal Direct Loan limit), there may be no aid available for the summer term.

Summer credits for full-time enrollment status is the same as it is during the regular school year (12 credits equals full-time, 9-11 credits equal three-quarter time, 6-8 credits equal half-time, and 1-5 credits equal less-than-half-time). This applies to all grants and loans.
