The student must complete either side one or side two of this document, do not complete both sides.

Students not appearing in person must have their signature witnessed by a Notary and must provide a copy of an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID). Notarized documents may not be photocopies or faxed. Only original notarized documents will be accepted.
