### American Legion Auxiliary Unit #222 2021/22 Scholarship

One scholarship in the amount of \$500 will be awarded for the 2021-22 school year. Other scholarships may be awarded based on fundraising efforts. The scholarship will be awarded by the Campbellsport American Legion Auxiliary Unit #222.

#### **RULES**

- 1. Candidates for this award shall be a Veteran/Member/Child or Grandchild of an American Legion or Auxiliary member based within 30 mile of Fond du lac County.
- 2. Applicant must be enrolled in a tuition based educational institution.
- 3. This is a scholarship to attend an accredited tuition based institution. Applicants must be of good character and have grades which meet entrance requirements at the institution of their choice. Applicants must have at least a 3.0 GPA using a 4.0 base.
- 4. Applicants must present the completed application to the American Legion Unit #222 On OR Before **APRIL 1, 2022.**
- 5. Judging shall be based on the following:

Character/Leadership 30%

Essay/Application 30%

GPA 40%

#### THE DECISION OF THE AUXILIARY UNIT #222 SHALL BE FINAL.

6. The entire award (\$500) will be paid to the school upon notification from the school that the student has registered for the 2022/23 school year.

American Legion Auxiliary Unit #222 must receive notification of enrollment by

August 1st or the scholarship will be forfeited. There shall be no money paid to the school until notification of enrollment has been received from the school. Notification from the school must include verification of a B (3.0) average. If the winner discontinues his/her education the scholarship will be forfeited. The winner will be eligible to utilize the scholarship for the 2022/23 school year or the scholarship will be forfeited.

#### **APPLICATION PACKET REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Complete application packet for the American Legion Auxiliary Unit #222 scholarship program.
- 2. The following two (2) letters of recommendation are required:
- a. One letter from either the principal, guidance counselor or teacher of the school from which the applicant attends or will graduate from.
- b. One letter from an adult citizen, other than relatives, attesting to the applicant's character in regards to conduct, citizenship and leadership.
- 3. An original essay consisting of no more than 1,000 words (typed, double spaced). The title of the essay will be "what amendment in the Bill of Rights is the most important to you and why?".
- 4. A certified transcript or photocopy of the certified transcript of the applicant's school grades.
- 5. Please be sure to attach all requirements to this application and submit to the American Legion auxiliary Unit #222 **NO LATER THAN APRIL 1, 2022**.
