Boot Camp Criteria: Strong math and reading scores are required to be accepted into the boot camp. Upon acceptance, students will attend classes one day per week. Classes will be held at Moraine Park Technical College's Fond du Lac Campus (235 N. National Avenue, Fond du Lac) in Room E-154/155.

Fees: \$1647.50 includes tuition, one-time \$30 admission fee and all materials. Course fees will be payable at the beginning of each semester.

Job Opportunities:

The skilled employee shortage is a major problem for industrial manufacturing. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS), Employment of industrial machinery mechanics is projected to grow 18 percent from 2014 to 2024, much faster than the average for all occupations. The increased adoption of sophisticated manufacturing machinery will require more mechanics to keep machines in good working order and their skills updated.
