

PRE-LICENSING INSURANCE CLASSES

Each applicant for licensing must complete, no more than 12 months earlier than exam date, at least 20 hours of pre-licensing education at an approved school prior to sitting for the examination. Classes can be taken individually, but all students need to take the 8-hour Ethics and Law class within 12 months of the exam date to be eligible for the Wisconsin state exams; once the 8-hours are complete, it need not be repeated for each product line.

All sections listed on this schedule meet the hour requirements as required by the Office of the Commissioner of Insurance. Moraine Park Technical College will issue course completion certificates.
