Please note the following update on your Spring 2021 Nursing Assistant courses at MPTC:

Greetings to all Spring 2021 Nursing Assistant Students!

Given the Covid-19 pandemic, you may notice changes within the Nursing Assistant class offered at MPTC. The Nursing Assistant course will continue to be 2-credits at 75 hours total.

Instead of students attending a health care agency for clinical you will have 16 hours of clinical in the lab. There will not be any clinical time spent in a health care agency for the Spring 2021 Nursing Assistant courses. Rest assured that your instructor will keep you informed on any updates as needed.

Course material requirements will be modified slightly for SPRING 2021 ONLY. Due to the fact that students are not attending clinical within a health care agency, you will not need to purchase scrubs for the Nursing Assistant course for Spring 2021 ONLY. We would like to note that although scrubs are not required for the MPTC course, scrubs are required for the state test if you wish to become certified. Other items not needed for the Spring 2021 Nursing Assistant course are a Urine Drug Screen and the purchase of a nametag. Health requirements/immunizations and Criminal Background Checks will still need to be completed for the course.
