

**Drug Test Instructions:**

**DO NOT GET THIS DONE UNTIL TOLD TO DO SO BY THE HEALTH REQUIREMENT REPRESENTATIVE!**

<b>Drug Screen (10 panel or greater)</b> <b><u>Must be done at one of the clinics listed below</u></b>	Final Drug Screen Report sent directly to MPTC.
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It is best to call first & make an appointment. DO NOT get it done through your healthcare provider. For drug screen, a driver's license or picture ID is required.

Be sure to verify costs and payment methods of any services. Please note that most clinics charge an **additional fee** for positive drug screen panel/prescription evaluation. Should a drug screen come back with a "negative-dilute" finding, students will be required to repeat the test at their own expense.

Should a currently enrolled student's drug screen be returned with a positive finding for any state or federally controlled substance prohibited by law the student will not be allowed to return to class, including participation in any off-site clinical, until such time as they have completed the necessary actions outlined in Procedure PR 723.03 Student Reasonable Suspicion procedure.
