

Drug Test Instructions:

DO NOT GET THIS DONE UNTIL TOLD TO DO SO BY THE HEALTH REQUIREMENT REPRESENTATIVE!

Drug Screen (10 panel or greater) Must be done at one of the clinics listed below	Final Drug Screen Report sent directly to MPTC.

It is best to call first & make an appointment. <u>DO NOT</u> get it done through your healthcare provider. <u>For drug screen</u>, a driver's license or picture ID is required.

Be sure to verify costs and payment methods of any services. Please note that most clinics charge an **additional fee** for positive drug screen panel/prescription evaluation. Should a drug screen come back with a "negative-dilute" finding, students will be required to repeat the test at their own expense.

Should a currently enrolled student's drug screen be returned with a positive finding for any state or federally controlled substance prohibited by law the student will not be allowed to return to class, including participation in any off-site clinical, until such time as they have completed the necessary actions outlined in Procedure PR 723.03 Student Reasonable Suspicion procedure.
