



Clinical Education Information

Students enrolled in Moraine Park Technical College’s Radiography Program are assigned clinical rotations in the Medical Imaging department under the supervision of a clinical preceptor or a staff technologist. During the time the student is assigned to clinical training she/he may be expected to participate not only in radiographic procedures but also the file room, patient transportation and other office procedures as long as their clinical education is not being compromised. Additionally, students practice professional work habits and appropriate interpersonal relationships with patients and members of the health care team. The preceptors/technologists supervise the student’s clinical performance, and all images must be evaluated by a Registered Radiologic Technologist. Students will be permitted to participate in clinical exams while they are attempting to, or have successfully completed instruction, and have demonstrated competency. Students who have satisfactorily completed and have been tested on the objectives of the radiographic procedures along with completing the required Clinical Competency Form for an exam will then be allowed to perform that radiographic examination under indirect supervision, but must have all images evaluated by a Registered Technologist. In the event a retake is necessary, a Registered Radiologic Technologist must accompany the student. The Radiography Program is committed to providing all students the opportunity to complete all required competencies mandated by the ARRT for successful completion of the MPTC Radiography program.
