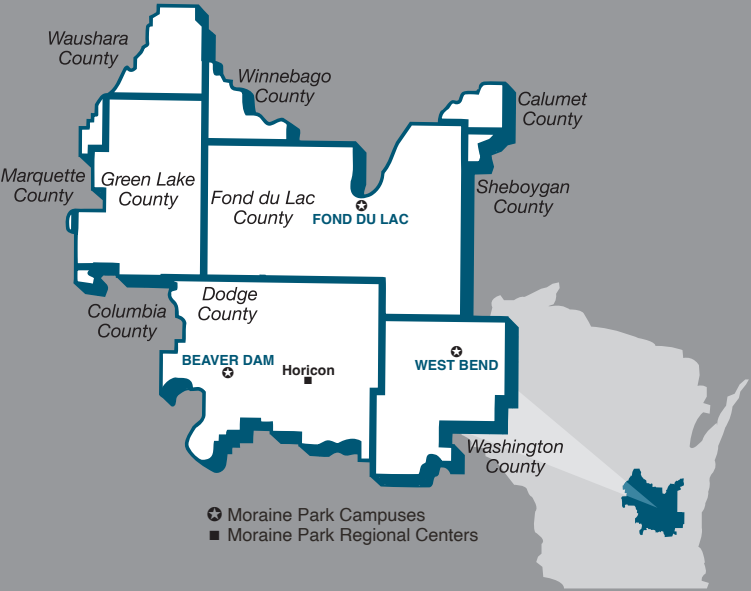

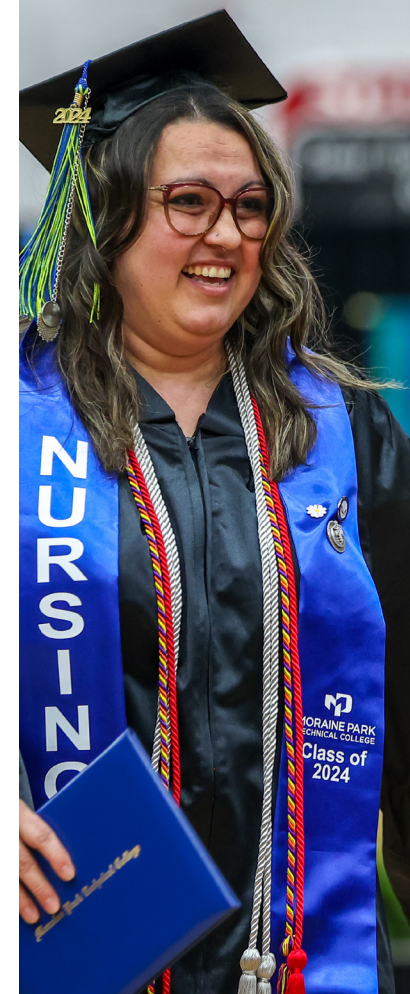

- 33 online programs and certificates

Our Students

- Moraine Park had 2,143 FTEs (full-time equivalent students)
 - Served 15,874 students
 - Provided Economic and Workforce Development training to 6,930 students
 - Median age of a program student was 24 (excludes high school students)
 - Enrollment status was 82 percent part-time and 18 percent full-time program students
 - Student diversity: 24 percent of students of color (Excludes unknown race/ethnicity)
 - 37 percent of eligible students received financial aid

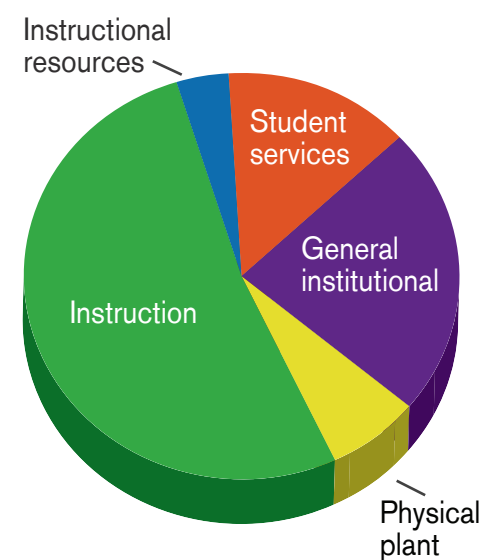
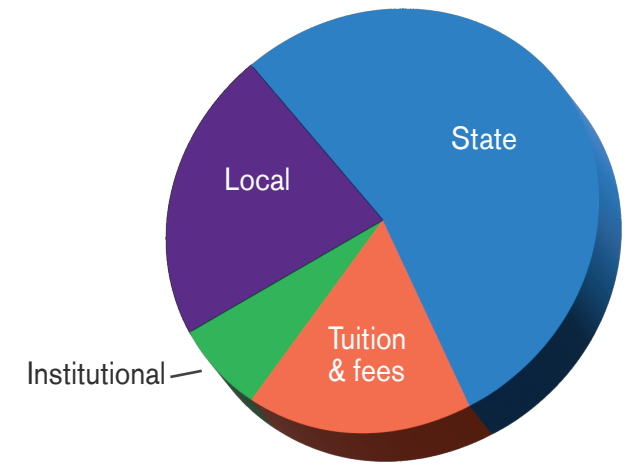
Our Graduates

- 94 percent of students were employed within six months of graduation.
- 52 percent of graduates worked within the Moraine Park district; 42 percent were employed elsewhere in Wisconsin.
